Re: Wantage & Grove Wide Information

In recent meetings at KCCG the topic of integrating new people into the wider community of Wantage and Grove has been discussed. There have been a wide variety of discussion varying from events to information. The key discussion point has focused on when people move into the Kingsgrove Estate, how are we able to inform them about everything that happens in their area of Wantage and Grove and not just Kingsgrove and not just Wantage.
