

Clerks report summary to Full Council on 8 September 2026
from the Full Council Meeting held on 28 July 2026

1. Minute 45(b) – Asset of Community Value (ACV). The Clerk informed the Council that he has almost completed the DRAFT ACV, and pending further final checks will bring forward for submission at the next meeting.
2. Minute 45(e) – New ride on mower. The Clerk informed the Council that the new ride on mower is still at LJ & CA Cannings awaiting vehicle registration documentation and a road lighting kit.
3. Minute 45(g) – Rialtas Business Solutions. The Clerk informed the Council that the Rialtas training packages have been completed by all necessary staff and that as soon as the RFO is content that all previous data has been copied over, the system will then go live.
4. Minute 45(h) – Repair of the Recreation Ground car park. The Clerk informed the Council that the car park white lining will be carried out on Tuesday 8 September 2026.
5. Minute 49(a) – DRAFT proposals for a new and Padel Tennis Court on the Recreation Ground and to give authority to the Clerk to apply for s106 funding from 17V34 - £383,149.00 (P12/V0299/O – Grove Airfield) and 14V08 - £32,389.79 (P12/V1545/O – Land West of Station Road). The Clerk informed the Council that whilst he has started the process of applying for the funds for this project, other matters are taking up most of his time.
6. Minute 49(b) – Considerations of options for the location for a proposed 3G floodlit sports pitch on Wellington Gate and to give authority to the Clerk to apply for s106 funding from various contributions and developments and for Council to consider funding for the remainder of the project. The Clerk informed the Council that following a special full council meeting held on 18 August 2026, Option 1 was considered the most viable and practicable.
7. Minute 50(a) – DRAFT proposals for public art on the Grove Meadows development (and extending towards the Westbrook Play Area) and to give the authority to the Clerk to apply for s106 funding from 14V08 - £40,155.67 (P12/V1545/O – Land West of Station Road) and from 15V16 - £10,094.33 (P14/V0576/O – Land West of Bellinger's Garage, Grove). The Clerk informed the Council he has now applied for s106 funding in respect of this art project.
8. Minute 50(b) – Venom aircraft. The Clerk informed the Council that he has not yet received the notes of the meeting between Robs Lamplough and the two District Council officers.
9. Minute 50(c) – Public Art working group. The informed the Council that Cllr Rolfe and Smeddle have now joined the Public Art working group, the full compliment of members forming this group are:

10. Minute 52 – Planning application P26/V1690/RM. The Clerk informed the Council that he has notified the Planning Authority of this Council's comments with regards to this application.
